Dominican University of California receives generous support from donors to be able to provide scholarships to students who need additional support in meeting their educational expenses. The Bernard Osher Foundation also assists re-entry students who have had an interruption of five (5) or more years in obtaining their first Bachelor's Degree.

The AAUW Marin Ann Ruane Lubamersky Scholarship assists female re-entry students who have had an interruption of five (5) or more years in obtaining their first Bachelor's Degree. This scholarship is open to all female undergraduate students who live in Marin County and have financial need.
